# **News from the Powder Springs Police Department** Attention:

Over the past few weeks the Powder Springs Police Department has had an increase of entering auto cases. The majority of these cases involve vehicles that are not locked. It appears the offenders are going around flipping door handles to see if vehicles are locked. If they are locked, they move on. If they find a vehicle unlocked, they take the opportunity and rummage through the vehicle looking for items to steal.

- Please remove all valuables from the vehicle when you arrive home. The majority of incidents have occurred between midnight and 6:00am.
- If you have video cameras at your house, please review any footage that may help and assist with identifying subjects of interest. If you do find suspicious activity on camera, please notify our Criminal Investigation Unit at 770-943-1616.
- Please call 911 if you see people walking around late at night in your neighborhood. We would rather come out and check on them rather not coming out at all. If you do call 911 to report suspicious activity, please provide the best description possible along with a direction of travel.

PARKING: Please be aware that parking on any unpaved area such as grass, dirt, or mulch is a violation the PPPHOA Covenants, City of Powder Springs Code and Cobb County Code. Vehicles may not be parked along the side of the road unless ALL parking spaces in the driveway are occupied. If a vehicle is parked alongside the road, it must not impede traffic or cause a dangerous situation. Your cooperation on this matter is greatly appreciated.

**ACC Violations:** There are some noticeable violations that we are asking neighbors to help correct immediately. These are not weather permitting items:

- Remove advertising signs in the yard, after work is complete
- Clean up toys (and trash) in front yards
- Company, commercial vehicles, and trailers must be parked inside your enclosed garage
- No overnight street parking
- Dogs must be on leashes and in control of owner
- Replace broken garage door windows
