

BROOKSTONE II TENNIS RULES

Effective March 15, 2021– April 30, 2022

THE FOLLOWING RULES MUST BE OBSERVED BY ALL MEMBERS USING THE TENNIS COURTS.

Court reservation must be made thru the community web site at www.brookstone2.com

1. **Tennis Courts are for playing tennis and pickle ball ONLY!! No kids on the courts at any time without an adult.** Footballs, whiffle balls, basketballs and any other type of ball are not to be played with on the courts.
2. Tennis courts are for the exclusive use of current Brookstone II Swim & Tennis Members. ***Guests are not allowed at this time.*** A Brookstone II resident who is not a member cannot be a guest of a member.
3. Courts 1 & 2 are lighted and are available for use from 9:00 AM until 9:00 PM
4. Proper attire is required. **Only soft soled tennis shoes are allowed. Running and track shoes or black soled shoes are not allowed, as they mark up the surface on the courts.** *Shirts must always be worn on courts.*
5. No food or GLASS is allowed on the courts. Drinks must be in plastic containers. NO SMOKING or VAPING on courts or playground area.
6. Please help clean up the courts before leaving. Empty the trash can when necessary.
7. Anyone under 16 years of age is only allowed on the courts if they are accompanied by an adult member.
8. Courts may be reserved as followed: 1. Reservations may be made no more than 2 days in advance. 2. Reservations are for a maximum of 1 & 1/2 hours for singles and doubles.
9. Profanity, throwing of rackets and other such emotional outbursts will not be tolerated. Failure to comply with this rule may result in removal from the courts and forfeiture of tennis privileges.
10. Cancel your reservation online if you need to cancel your court.
11. **No pets are allowed in the tennis area.**
12. Children who are not playing tennis are not permitted on the courts.
13. No bicycles, strollers, playpens, skateboards, skates, roller blades or similar equipment are allowed on the tennis courts. Please have your children refrain from shooting of pellet guns around the tennis area and into the tennis courts.
